



STUD NEWS – FEB 2011 – VOLUME 1 - REVISED

This REVISED edition of Stud News shows a number of corrections against Classes 1 to 19 due to errors with the dates printed in the February 2011, Volume 1 Stud News. All other information in the first edition is reproduced again here.

STUD NEWS has been developed by the Beef Australia 2012 Stud Cattle Committee to keep exhibitors, breed societies, judges and stewards well informed of various aspects of the planning and development of the Beef Australia 2012 Stud Cattle Championships.

PROGRAMME

The programme for Beef Australia 2012 will be the same as for Beef Australia 2009 i.e. Stud Judging occurring over 3 days, commencing on Tuesday, 8 May at 11am.

AGE

The age of all stud cattle will be the actual age as at 1 May 2012 with cows over 48 months not eligible to be entered. This is a change from the rule for Beef Australia 2009 when the age was from 1 April 2009.

20. Exhibitors Group

Comprising three (3) head with both sexes to be represented and to have been exhibited in their respective classes by the same exhibitor.

21. Sires Progeny Stakes.

Comprising three (3) head, both sexes represented by the same sire, exhibited by the same exhibitor and shown in their respective classes. The name of the sire is to be included with the nomination.

22. Dam's Progeny Stakes.

Comprising of two (2) head, the same or different sexes exhibited by the same exhibitor and shown in their respective classes. The name of the dam is to be included with nomination.

JUNIOR LED STEER CLASSES

Judging of junior led steer will take place at the Rockhampton Showgrounds on Tuesday, 8 May 2012. There will be no carcass competition attached to the led steer competition. It is the responsibility of the guardian to ensure that presenters are capable of handling their exhibit. Exhibitors are to be under 19 years of age.

23. For Milk Tooth Steers or Heifers to be exhibited by an exhibitor under 11 years of age.
24. For Milk Tooth Steers or Heifers with a live weight of 350kg – 450kg
25. For Milk Tooth Steers and Heifers with a live weight of 451kg – 525kg
26. For Milk Tooth Steers or Heifers with a live weight of 526kg – 600kg
27. For Milk Tooth Steers or Heifers with a live weight of 601kg and over

YOUNG JUDGES, YOUNG PARADERS & SCHOOL'S TEAM JUDGING COMPETITIONS

All three competitions will be held on Friday, 11th May 2012 at the Rockhampton Showgrounds.



INTERBREED

The Beef Australia 2012 Interbreed will be judged immediately after the Parade of Champions on Thursday 10 May, 2012.

ENTRY INTO GROUNDS

Entry into the Rockhampton Showgrounds will be permitted from Wednesday 2nd May 2012.

TICK REQUIREMENTS

It is envisaged that the status of control will be as required for Beef Australia 2009. Full details of control as required by the Queensland Department of Primary Industries & Fisheries stock inspectors will be available in the schedule.

ACCOMMODATION

Camping for exhibitors will be available at the Rockhampton Showgrounds and can be booked at time of nomination.

TRADE FAIR CATTLE SITES

The Trade Fair Prospectus will be released in August with limited cattle sites available. If you would like to receive a copy of the prospectus please contact the office. Sale of sites will be on a first come, first served basis. Cattle can be shown out of trade sites but this must be noted at time of nomination.

TEETH SCHEDULE

All Bos Indicus Cattle

- Under 20 mths – Milk Teeth
- 20 and under 25 mths – 2 teeth
- 25 and under 30 mths – 4 teeth
- 30 and under 36 mths – 6 teeth

Bos Taurus, Euro and Small Breed Cattle

- Under 18 mths – Milk teeth
- 18 and under 24 mths – 2 teeth
- 24 and under 30mths – 4 teeth
- 30 and under 36 mths – 6 teeth

Any animal nominated with incorrect teeth will be ineligible to compete in the nominated class and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
