

## **Report on New Dimension Braford Sale held at Jimbour Station on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2008**

### Summary:

22 Braford Bulls – Top \$6 500 – Avg \$3 989 – 95.5% Clearance

14 Registered Braford Females – Top \$2 250 – Avg \$1 250 – 78% Clearance

20 Commercial Braford Females – Top \$1 500 – Avg \$1 040 – 95% Clearance

A large crowd attended the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual New Dimension Bull & Female sale at historic Jimbour Station on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> August 23 Braford Bulls, 18 Registered and 21 Commercial Braford Females offered for sale.

On two occasions Braford Bulls sold for a Top Price of \$6 500 – both bulls being purchased by repeat buyer and 1<sup>st</sup> time New Dimension vendor Ray Kidd – “Old Cashmere” St George. The First bull Lot 18 – 20 month old Carinya Jonah, weighing 760kg with an EMA of 115 sq cm offered by John & Jackie Amor – “Carinya” stud at Dulacca and the 2<sup>nd</sup> bull Lot 27 – 22 month old Sunnyslawn Royal Bear, weighing 806kg with an EMA of 121sq cm offered by Niel Pacholke – “Sunnyslawn” stud at Clifton.

Coincidentally on two occasions Registered Braford Females sold for a Top Price of \$2 250. These two heifers came from the older section of the Registered Braford Female catalogue. The first heifer being Lot 44 – 22 month old Carinya 2040 offered by John & Jackie Amor – “Carinya” stud at Dulacca and purchased by – Darren & Lise Thomas – “Darralise” stud at Scrubby Mountain. The second heifer being Lot 49 - 21 month old Strathgyle Brandy offered by the McNamara Family – “Strathgyle” stud at Bell and purchased by Ken Miers from Cashmere.

A Top Price of \$1 250 was paid in the younger section of the Registered Braford Female catalogue being Lot 62 - 12 month old Boomerang Willow offered by Artie & Del Kehl – “Boomerang” stud at Wallumbilla and purchased by the Donovan Family – “Ashby” stud at Jimbour.

A Top Price of \$1500 for Commercial Braford Females was reached on two occasions with commercial females offered by John & Jackie Amor – “Carinya” stud at Dulacca, with both females being purchased by long time supporter of the New Dimension Sale Mrs Evelyn Graving of Biloela.

Volume buyers of the day were RE, JM, KL & MR Davies of Yarraman taking home 7 Braford Females for an average of \$1 014.
